

Since opening its doors in **1984**, the Ronald McDonald House of Northwest Florida has provided service for over **16,000** families.

2008 FAMILIES

Quick Facts About Families Served in 2008:

6,625 family member stays were provided
55 military families utilized **545** room stays
1,621 rooms were provided to families battling prematurity
211 rooms were provided to families battling respiratory challenges
169 rooms were provided to families needing surgery
Other rooms were provided for families whose children were involved in traumas, battling cancer, searching for a diagnosis and more...

Unfortunately, from **2006** to **2008**, the House had to turn away families away nearly **3,200** times due to a lack of space. Therefore, we have launched a Capital Campaign to raise **\$5 million** to build a new, larger Home-Away-From-Home for children and families suffering a medical crisis.

87 families from Bay County (717 room stays)
30 families from Walton County (347 room stays)
16 families from Santa Rosa County (133 room stays)
12 families from Washington County (171 room stays)
6 families from Jackson County (26 room stays)
4 family from Escambia County (28 room stays)
4 families from Holmes County (38 room stays)
3 families from Gulf County (27 room stays)
