The winning schools with the most number of pop tabs per student were:

**1st Place** - St Paul Catholic School Kindergarten Class

**2nd Place** - Kids Discovery

**3rd Place and Most Pop Tabs Collected Overall** - West Navarre Primary with 652.5 lbs of pop tabs! The most ever collected by one school.

**1st Place Team**- Pace High School NJROTC

This year we would love **ALL** area schools to help us make our 8<sup>th</sup> Annual Pop Tab Pandemonium an even greater success.

How to participate:

- Complete the attached registration form. Mail, fax or hand deliver it to the House by the deadline **September 16, 2009**.
- Ask students and staff to collect tabs at home and bring them to school.
- Put collection containers in your classrooms, the cafeteria, etc.
- Collect as many Pop Tabs as you can.
- Make sure all Pop Tabs that need to be weighed are brought to the Ronald McDonald House by 4pm Friday May 14, 2010. All checks and weights from the recycler are required by this date to be considered as part of the competition.

Tip for success:

- If you bring tabs to the House throughout the school year, please let us know that they are for **Pop Tab Pandemonium** and include a **Pandemonium TAG** with each set of pop tabs you drop off. (TAGs are included with this mailing.)
- If you are taking tabs directly to a recycler, please take them to Wise Recycling in Pensacola. Make sure that **prior to the weighing** you tell them that the check should be made payable to the Ronald McDonald House. After the tabs are weighed ask for a receipt. Please note: the Ronald McDonald House needs the weight of the tabs collected as well as the check.

Thank you for your continued support of the Ronald McDonald House. Every tab makes a difference to help families of children in crisis.
